

# **RESUME?** or **CURRICULUM VITAE (CV)?**

Resume comes from the French word for "summary." Curriculum Vitae, often called a CV, means "course of life" in Latin. What's the difference? Will you need both?

A resume presents a concise summary of your background, including job-relevant information such as education and experience, formatted to fit on one page, two at maximum. A CV is more detailed, designed to provide a full history of your academic credentials, so it's typically appropriate to be longer.



Both are tailored to the specific position, program or company/institution you are applying to. Both typically do not include a description of personal interests.

## **Format and Content**

In general, you'll need a resume to apply for a position at a business, not-for-profit and government entity; a CV is required for individuals seeking fellowships, grants, post-doctoral positions and teaching/research positions in post-secondary academic institutions. Graduate school applications typically request a CV, but in general are looking for a resume with detailed descriptions of research projects and publications.

Did you know?

In some European countries, the term "CV" is used to describe all job application documentation, including a resume. In the United States and Canada, the two terms are sometimes used interchangeably. When in doubt, ask for clarification.

## A Resume...

Emphasizes skills, experience and education

- Is used when applying for a position in industry, non-profit and public sectors
- Should generally be one page, and not be longer than two pages

Often features skills-focused experience sections such as "Software Engineering Experience" or "Community Outreach Experience"

A resume is not static and is generally edited for each role
